Origin of CIL&B

- Launch of CILB, the Club Linear Infrastructures and Biodiversity, in october 2008
- Signature of commitments charter in june 2011



Targets:

- Mutualize knowledge, experience feedback
- Power of share with identification of biodiversité referents
- Actions in work
- Change the look on our infrastructures
- Become a recognize actor in the landscape on the biodiversity

1. Continuous actions

- Representation in the authorities of biodiversity governance :
 - National level: CILB member of the National Comity of Green and blue network
 - Regional level : CILB is represented in the regional comity of Green and blue network

To defend positions and interests of all the CILB members and to get information from the comity.

- Communication and special event managements :
 - Organization of special event managements, contribution to special events, communication
- Regulatory monitoring, legal watch
- Investment in research :
 - Participation to the Strategic Orientation Comity of FRB (Research Foundation for Biodiversity)



2. Partnership between CILB and MNHN

Context

- Datas relative to biodiversity are incomplete and dispatched
- Biodiversity studies ordered by the infrastructure managers for impact assessment product lot's of naturalist datas under exploited
- Partnership with MNHN Natural Heritage Service
 - The NHS manages the naturalist databanks at the national level
 - The NHS coordinate the scientific biodiversity inventories
 - Convention signed at the end of 2013
- Targets
 - Standardization of the naturalist datas in the biodiversity studies
 - Sustainability of the datas via bankarisation
 - Valorisation of the datas in the national inventory (participative science)



3. CILB – UICN meeting in 2014

- Organisation of a work seminar on the specific thema of «Infrastructures and ecological continuities», at the end of 2014
 - To gather our stake holders around this question
 - To valorise our actions and to overcome the brakes
 - To identify new strands of work

L'UICN (French Comity of the International Union for Nature Conservation) helps the CILB to prepare, organize and host the seminar



4. Call for Projects CILB – ITTECOP – FRB

Actors

- CILB: 6 members: RFF, VNF, TIGF, GRT Gaz, ERDF et RTE
- > ITTECOP: Direction of research (ecological ministry)
- > FRB: Fundation for the Biodiversity Research: confluence point between the different scientific and operationnal actors working on the biodiversity topic

Targets

- Collect scientifical results about contribution of the green dependances of linear infrastructures to the ecological continuities
- Collect scientific results about synergies between infrastructures



4. Call for research projects CILB-ITTECOP-FRB

Contents

- State of knowledge
- Call for research projects
 - Research projects over 3 years
 - Exploratory projects over 1 year

Planning

- Launch of the CRP 8th november 2013, with deadline 11th february 2014
- Selection of the candidates on april 2014 :
 - 24 research projects
 - 20 exploratory projects
- Launch of the research projects at the end of october

Financing

> CILB: 630 000 €

MEDDE: 800 000 €
